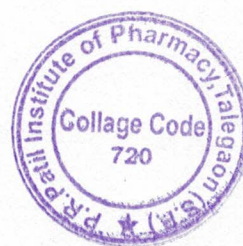
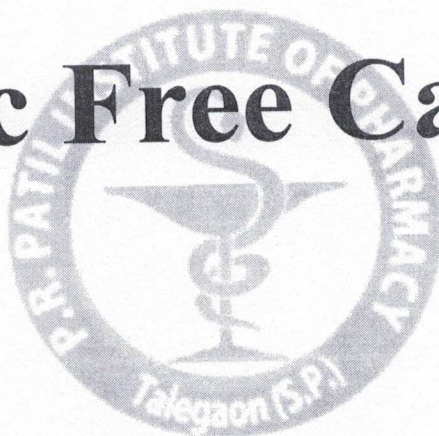


# **Policy Document on Green Campus / Plastic Free Campus**



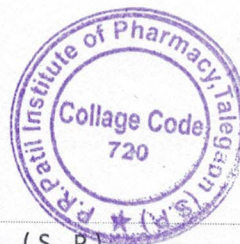

## Training and Awareness

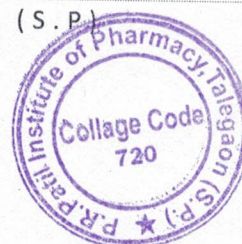
### Training Programs:

**Initiatives:****a. Waste Management:**

- i. Recycling Stations: Establish clearly marked recycling stations across the campus for paper, plastic, glass, and other recyclable materials.
- ii. Composting: Implement a campus-wide composting program to reduce organic waste and create nutrient-rich compost for landscaping purposes.

**b. Plastic-Free Campus:**

- i. Single-use Plastic Ban: Prohibit the use of single-use plastics on campus, including plastic bags, straw, water bottles, and food containers.
- ii. Reusable Alternative: Promote the use of reusable alternative such as water bottles, coffee mugs, and lunch containers by providing incentives, discounts, or free alternatives.

**e. Tree Plantation:**

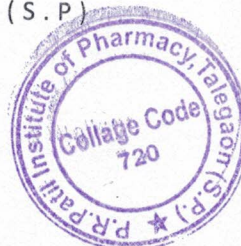
Initiate and maintain a tree plantation program to increase green cover on campus, providing shade, enhancing aesthetics, and contributing to carbon sequestration.

Conduct regular audits to assess compliance with this policy and identify areas for improvement.

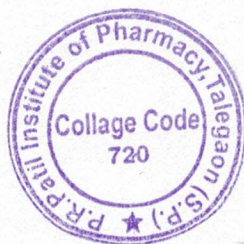
**Continuous Improvement**
